During the introductory workshop on 20/21 July 2013, organized by the Goethe Institute and conducted with Artist Markus Heinsdorff at Hindustan University, experimental possibilities in textile mobile and permanent structural design for diverse climates were investigated with students of Architecture.

The goal of the workshop was to develop new forms of living and mobility with appealing design and innovative technology attractive for all parts of society, that could be used even internationally and serve people without shelter as a home.

The exhibition is being conducted in cooperation with Hindustan University Chennai and Artist Markus Heinsdorff, Germany, with contributions from University of Applied Science Detmold, Germany and the Earth Institute Auroville.
